Classroom Procedures

Class will begin immediately with the daily Warm Up on the front board. You will also be expected to have your homework out and corrected using a different colored pen/pencil.

Assignments are also posted on Ms. Czarnik's Teacher Page that can be accessed through the PEHS Website. You are responsible for checking your own Lesson Practice answers. We will only go over problems requested by students in class.

The period will end when I dismiss you, not the bell.

DO NOT pack up early.

DO NOT line up at the door.

Hall Passes

Supplies

You are expected to have the following supplies with you daily:

- Graphing Calculator (TI 84+ or TI 84 CE preferred)
- Organizational System (3 ring binder with tabs is STRONGLY recommended)
- Geometry Textbook (SpringBoard) – distributed first week of class
- Pencil/Eraser – (colored pens/pencil may be useful for notes)

Calculator

A graphing calculator is required for this course.



TI 84+ is preferred

TI 83+ is acceptable

Lesson Practice/Homework and Classwork

Lesson Practice/Homework will be given daily. Lesson Practice is expected to be done on notebook paper and corrected in class each day with a different colored pen/pencil. Along with nightly practice, students are expected to complete all in-class assignments. This will include Daily Warm-Ups, Class Notes, Group Work, and Embedded Assessments. Lesson Practice/Homework and in-class work will be kept in a binder. Binders will be checked randomly throughout a unit and at the end of each unit. Late work will not be accepted after the day of the Unit Test.

Absences

When you are absent, it is your responsibility to check the Algebra 2 Binder in the back of the room (on the counter). Further, you should check the calendar on my Teacher Page for lessons/assignments, and you will need to copy notes from a classmate. If you missed a test or quiz, you have one day for each day absent to make it up. You can make it up after school or during your study hall. Please see me to schedule your make-up.

Assessments/Tests

A Unit Test will be given at the end of each unit of study, and some units may be divided into two separate Unit Tests.

Any student may retake **ONE** Unit Test per semester. The Retake Test is another version of the original test in order to better demonstrate your understanding of the material. You will need to have homework complete and seek additional help prior to retaking the Unit Assessment. To notify me of your desire to retake the assessment, you will need to turn in a completed "Request to Retest" form within a week of receiving your original score.
